Ask for a chat

It seems that people like the straightforward, practical approach that we've developed here at Career Insiders. It involves understanding and using human nature to one's advantage, and it works. For example, when talking about how to use informational interviews strategically in a job search, we recommend asking for a *chat* which is defined as *an informal conversation or talk conducted in an easy familiar manner* and implies a shorter amount of time, making it easier for the targeted contact to say yes. It seems like such a tiny difference that it's easy to think it wouldn't matter, but it does.

Talent Acquisition

We use the same approach with our recruiting clients to help them hire top performing talent. LinkedIn is a terrific recruitment tool that we use aggressively, but our network has been built over many years of successful matchmaking, and we believe that using a personal touch is still the most effective.
